Fu Hui (Canada) Foundation:

- Established in late 2004 as a Canadian registered charity
 - Composition of Board members (Business, Professional, Educator, Entrepreneur)
 - Objective is to assist children and teenagers in China to receive proper education
 - Student sponsorship program
 - Fu Hui orphans program
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Student sponsorship program:

- Selected second tier universities or colleges
- Worked with Student counseling office to select recipients
- Directors/Volunteers hand the funds to recipients in person
- Small group discussion with recipients
- Continuing mentoring through letters or emails
- Recipients volunteer to conduct orphans home visits during summer holidays

AIM:

- Building up confidence
 - Promoting the concepts of charity and volunteerism among the students
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Fu Hui orphans program:

- Started in 2006
 - Allow orphans (age 7-11) to receive care, love and education
 - Concentrated in Liangshan, Sichuan
 - Partnership with local government
 - Convert school classrooms into boarding facilities
 - Hire nannies to nurture them and teach them personal hygiene
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Fu Hui orphans program (continue):

- Home visit by university students
 - Training program and workshop for school principals, teachers and nannies
 - Consultation and full support from University of Hong Kong Social Work Faculty and also local universities

Our unique features:

- Emphasis on proper education
 - Sound Governance and very tight supervision /management control
 - Collaboration with universities and government agencies
 - Significant pool of directors and volunteers in Toronto, Hong Kong and China
 - Many directors and volunteers are entrepreneurs who are very well-connected and resourceful in Asia with tremendous network in Asia
 - Board members and Volunteers pay for all their own traveling expenses
 - Zero admin cost – donation 100% used on direct programs
 - Act as mentors and pen pals for the sponsored students.
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Our special connection with Sichuan:

- 10 schools and 515 students in Sichuan (70% of our 2007 total)
 - All 580 orphans are from Sichuan
 - Have been working closely with Sichuan government over past three years
 - Ada Tang, one of our VPs, is a member of the Sichuan Committee of Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (四川省政協委員)
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Our Sichuan earthquake relief efforts:

- Emphasis on good quality, low cost and fast delivery
 - The following items have arrived at or are being manufactured and shipped to Sichuan:
 - 10,865 sleeping bags
 - 5,793 tents
 - 450 pre-fabricated houses
 - Total budget over Cdn\$1 mm
 - So far, over \$600,000 has been raised

Our future plan:

- Long-term assistance through ongoing regular communication with local governments
 - Continuing assessment of supplies or needs of affected areas and fund raising
 - Emphasis on enabling allowing youth and children to resume education and normal life
 - Provide financial assistance to youth and children in need by selecting additional schools from the earthquake areas
 - Provide mentorship to youth and children in earthquake areas
 - Collaborate with other agencies such as the Social Work Faculties of U of T and Hong Kong University
